- Enter the site at the Colony Farm Road traffic light. Take Holly Drive through the hospital grounds, then go uphill on Oak Crescent, and the H.E.Y. building is on your right on Kalmia Drive. Find parking, & meet at the front door.
- Bus #177 goes through the grounds. Bus stops are on Holly at Sorrel and on Holly at Lilac.
